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Open Flame Cooking Devices on Combustible Balconies & Decks

Liquid Petroleum-gas cooking devices having Liquid Petroleum-gas (propane) container with a water capacity less than 2.5 pounds are allowed and may be used in any outside space. Electric grills with no solid fuel (wood or pellets) or flame are authorized as long as they do not have solid fuel or flame. Infrared or electric grills (that heat with electric element) are okay. Please keep in mind that any legal cooking device generating smoke that becomes a nuisance for neighbors is enforced through the City of Fort Collins Nuisance Ordinance or the Larimer County Health Department.

It is suggested that there be no more than one extra 2.5 pound cylinder on hand at any time. They may be stored outside or in a detached garage.

Charcoal grills are not allowed; solid fuel (wood or pellets) is not allowed. Fire pits are banned from Silverplume as well.

The purpose of bringing this to your attention is to keep our complex as safe as possible by following the Poudre Fire Authority regulations and using a responsible common sense approach when grilling.
